Modular Double Base Units with Kneespace Assembly Instructions

Components:

• 16 - Base Assembly Screws, #8 x 1 3/8" PFH

If unit has a "modular file"

• 10 – Screws, #8 x 1 3/8" PFH (Quantity Per Cabinet)

If unit has a "modular storage cabinet"


- 10 Screws, #8 x 5/8" PPH (Quantity Per Cabinet)
- 2 Screws, #8 x 1 3/8" PFH (Quantity Per Cabinet)

Units Required:

- 2 Modular Storage Cabinet or Modular File
- 2 Modular Cabinet / Credenza Base
- 1 Modular Triple Cabinet / Credenza Top
- 1 If installing two cabinets with a space between them, both cabinets are inset 34" from each end of the top and 34" from the front of the top.
- 2 If a "modular file", insert screws through mounting rails and fasten cabinet to the top.

If a "modular storage cabinet", insert 5/8" screws through the metal brackets on the end and back panel and two 1 3/8" screws through the top front rail and fasten the cabinet to the top.

- **3** To assemble to base assemblies to the cabinets, turn the cabinets upside down and align the base assemblies on the cabinets.
- 4 Insert the screws through the mounting strips on the bases and fasten to the cabinets. (as shown)
- **5** Insert levelers into the base assemblies.
- **6** Turn the entire unit to the upright position and level as needed.
