## Components:

- 8 - Base Screws, \#8 x 1 3/8" PFH (Quantity Per Cabinet)

If unit has a "modular file"

- 10 - Screws, \#8 x $13 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ PFH (Quantity Per Cabinet)

If unit has a "modular storage cabinet"

- 10 - Screws, \#8 x 5/8" PPH (Quantity Per Cabinet)
- 2 - Screws, \#8 x 1 3/8" PFH (Quantity Per Cabinet)


## Units Required:

- 2 or 3 - Modular Storage Cabinet or Modular File
- 1 - Modular Double or Triple Cabinet / Credenza Base
- 1 - Modular Double or Triple Cabinet / Credenza Top
(1) Stand the cabinets upright next to one another.
(2) Align the cabinets flush with one another side by side. You may have to use a bar clamp or a strap clamp to temporarily hold the cabinets tightly together.

3 Fasten the units together by drilling pilot holes and inserting four $13 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ screws through the cabinet's end.
(4) To assemble cabinet to top center the top on the cabinet from front to back and side to side with approximately $3 / 4$ " spacing all around.

5 If a modular unit or file, insert screws through mounting rails and fasten cabinet to the top.

If a modular storage, insert $5 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ screws through the metal brackets on the end and back panel and two $13 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ screws through the top front rail and fasten the cabinet to the top.

6 To assemble the cabinet to the base assembly turn the cabinet upside down and align the base on the cabinet.
(7) Insert the screws through the mounting strips on the base and fasten to the cabinet.

8 Insert levelers into base assembly, then turn the entire unit upright. Position and level the unit as needed.
