- Incorporate use of the BIFMA Compliant product registry as a free resource to identify safe and durable furniture products.

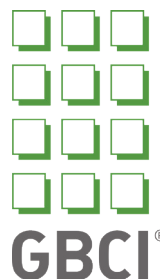
